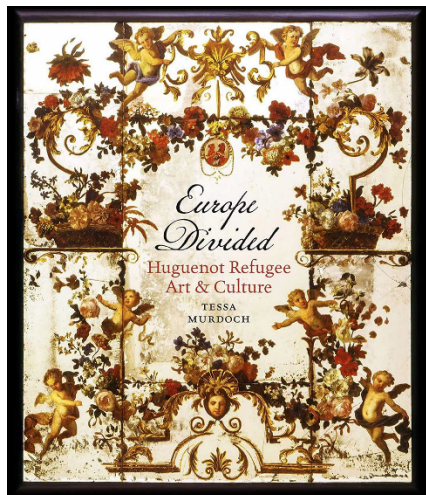


Invitation to the Goldsmiths' Company's Winter 2022 lecture

When Huguenot craftspeople fled France in the late 17th century to find religious freedom, they swelled an extraordinary international network of talent. Their skill, sophistication and determination over succeeding generations had a huge impact on the quality of design and workshop practice in their new homes, not least on the goldsmiths, jewellers and watchmakers of the City of London. Dr Tessa Murdoch will draw on research for her new book, *Europe Divided: Huguenot Refugee Art and Culture*, to explore their impact on London goldsmithing.
